2019 SuperTech Maryland

The American Trucking Associations Technology & Maintenance Council holds the National Technician Skills Competition (“Supertech”) each year to recognize the skills of diesel truck and bus technicians around the country. This event is supported by those states that have launched their own competitions.

Maryland is one of those states.

What is SuperTech Maryland?

A hands-on contest where technicians gather to test their abilities against their peers. It showcases the knowledge, training and skill needed by today’s maintenance professionals.

What skills are tested?

The event begins with a written test based on TMC Recommended Practices and/or Manufacturers’ Practices. Contestants then proceed to hands-on skill stations, where they have 20 minutes to complete each station.

Stations include:

- Engine electrical – troubleshoot, service and repair engine electronics and related systems
- Preventive maintenance – demonstrate ability to perform preventive maintenance procedures
- Fasteners – demonstrate ability to service and repair fasteners
- Fifth wheel – conduct a hands on diagnostic and preventive maintenance inspection on a fifth wheel
- Service information – retrieve service information from currently accepted industry sources
- Brakes – perform tasks in accordance with USDOT, CVSA and perform disc brake inspection and adjustments compliant with the relevant procedures
- Wheel End – troubleshoot, service and repair wheel ends
- Precision Measuring – accurately measure various components and document the dimensions; exercises on reading micrometers and calculating clearances
- CSA Compliance – technicians will be tested on their knowledge of CVSA Out-of-Service and FMCSA regulation (Appendix G) criteria
- Electrical – use a volt, amp and ohm meter to test circuits and components

Saturday, June 22, 2019, CAT North, 800 Stevenson Rd. Severn MD 21144.

Who can participate?

Any truck or bus technician in Maryland or a neighboring state without its own event.
All competitors will receive a study packet upon registering.



What can you win?

Winners receive over \$5,000 in cash and prizes including tablets, trophies, a trip to the national TMC competition and more. All contestants receive lunch, an event t-shirt, and a goody bag.
